# COVID FAQ

**We will be following all Santa Clara County guidelines and the requirements of the restaurant, which may change at any point before the event**

## **WILL THE EVENT BE OUTDOORS?**

Yes! The reserved event space is outdoors but the restrooms are located indoors.

## **WILL I NEED TO WEAR A MASK?**

Current Santa Clara County mandates require everyone to wear a mask indoors regardless of vaccination status so you will need to wear a mask when you use the restrooms or pass through the restaurant. Masks are not required in our outdoor space but we encourage you to wear one if that would make you feel more comfortable.

## **WHAT IF SOMEONE TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID?**

When you check in, we will be taking your contact information, confirming you feel well, and checking your temperature. Should you test positive within a few days of the event, we ask you to let our chapter leadership know so we can inform other guests that someone at the event tested positive. We will not be able to tell you who due to privacy regulations. If you feel unwell the day of the event, please do not come! We will happily refund your registration for you.
